Night closure of Borella
Road between Young and Schubach streets

Borella Road will be temporarily closed between Young and Schubach streets on Monday 23 January 2006 and Tuesday 24 January 2006 from 10pm to 5.45am each night.

The temporary closure is required to enable transport and placement of girders by crane for a new bridge over the freeway.

In order to minimise disruption to traffic, this essential activity requires work out of the normal construction hours.

Detour for light vehicles

The signposted detour for light vehicles travelling east from the Hume Highway (Mate Street) to Borella Road will be via Fallon Street, Jelbart Road, North Street and Keene Street.

Detour for heavy vehicles

The signposted detour for heavy vehicles travelling east from the Hume Highway (Mate Street) to Borella Road will be via Fallon Street and Elizabeth Mitchell Drive.

Noise and Vibration monitoring

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of works.

Noise and vibration will be monitored in accordance with the project's environmental management plan.
