Changes to traffic
conditions at *roll over corner* on Hume Highway

Traffic reduced to one lane in each direction

Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction at "roll over corner" (corner of Hume and Young streets) on the Hume Highway in Albury from 9am on Monday 13 March.

Construction of new T-intersection with traffic lights

This change to traffic conditions is required to build a T-intersection with traffic lights at the location by mid April 2006.

The new intersection will connect the junction of Hume and Young streets with the new Atkins Street link, currently under construction, as part of the Hume Freeway project.

One lane of traffic flow in each direction will be maintained at all times.

Works including reconstructing the pavement, adjusting the median barriers and realigning the road will be staged to ensure one lane of traffic flow in each direction at all times.

Construction work hours

Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm. Saturday 8am – 1pm.

Nearby residents will be advised of any construction works occurring outside normal construction hours.

Motorists and pedestrians are asked to observe all signage and traffic control directions to ensure public safety.
